## REGULATIONS 1ST NORTHERN YOUTH FORUM

### GENERAL PROVISIONS

These Regulations determine the purpose, objectives, procedure, program and conditions for participation in the 1<sup>st</sup> Northern Youth Forum (hereinafter – 1<sup>st</sup> NYF).

NYF is held in accordance with:

- Key priorities of the Northern Forum Non-Profit Organization (hereinafter - the Northern Forum);
- Program of the Northern Sustainable Development Forum (hereinafter – NSDF).

Organizers of the Forum are:

- Initiative group of the youth;
- Northern Forum;
- Organizers of the NSDF.

### GOAL AND OBJECTIVES OF THE 1ST NYF

THE PURPOSE OF THE 1ST NYF is to promote the interests and views of young people in solving problems facing the Northern Forum by using potential of international youth cooperation.

THE OBJECTIVES OF THE 1ST NYF:

- Creation of a platform for international youth cooperation;
- Involvement of active youth in processes of solving the most urgent and promising social, economic, political, environmental, cultural and other issues facing the North and the Arctic;
- Assistance to social, scientific, educational and creative self-realization of the youth.

The 1<sup>st</sup> NYF will be held within the Northern Sustainable Development Forum scheduled on September 27-30, 2020.
